



The Tanzania Kilimo Tija (Horticulture Productivity) Project (KTP) is a five-year initiative by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) aimed at sustainably increasing economic opportunities in horticulture market systems, with a focus on youth. Fintrac Global Inc. (FGI), a member of the Kilimo Tija consortium led by Prime Implementer ACDI/VOCA, plays a key role in achieving Intermediate Result (IR) 2: supporting producers—particularly youth—in adopting good agricultural practices (GAPs) and accessing agricultural production technologies to enhance resilience and productivity. FGI contributes through targeted interventions to expand quality extension services, increase access to productivity-enhancing inputs and technologies, and promote the inclusion of youth and women.

### FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2024 ACHIEVEMENTS

FGI built the capacity of **509 government extension officers** who cascaded training to **31,399 farmers**.

Simultaneously, FGI improved the input supply chain by providing product knowledge training to **186 agro-dealers**, including those at the village level.

Trainings were conducted on **248 demonstration plots** during the FY.



**36,325 participants** attended climate-smart agriculture trainings.

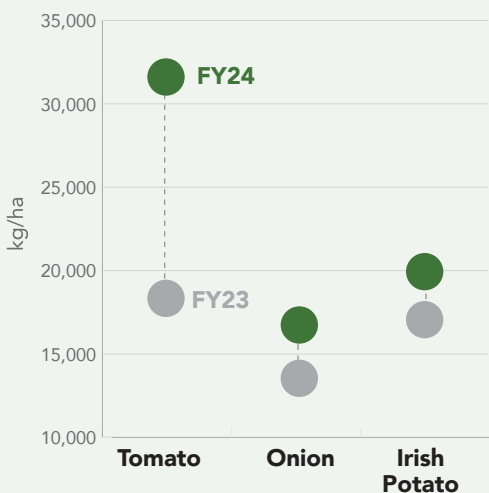

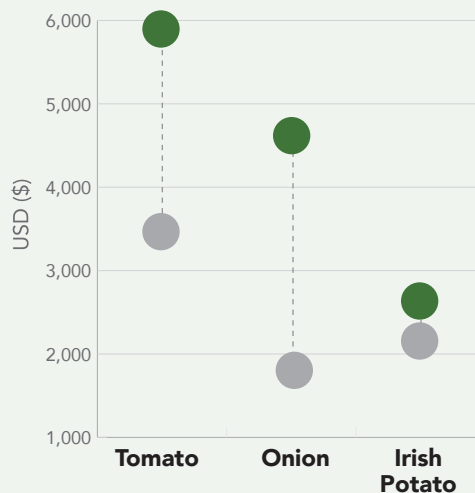
